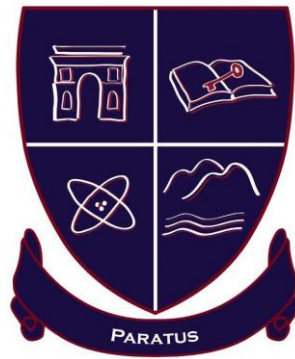


The Mountain Cambridge School



TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ADMISSION

This letter must be co-signed by both parents/guardian(s), confirming acceptance of the Terms and Conditions for Admission to Mountain Cambridge School.

1. Consideration will be given to all applicants. Admission to the school is at the discretion of the Principal or person delegated in the absence of the Principal.
2. No student shall be precluded on the basis of race, colour, gender, religion or creed.
3. Students, who are more than two years than the average age of their grade, will not be considered for enrolment.
4. Parents/guardians are requested to provide information on known disabilities of the students.
5. Applicants must possess the required level of competence to cope with the school's curriculum. The school reserves the right to conduct a scholastic assessment prior to admitting the applicant. Should a scholastic assessment be required, this will be at the parents' expense.
6. Applications will not be considered unless all the required documentation and information is provided.
7. Parent/Guardian acceptance of the Terms of Admission of Mountain Cambridge School provides prior permission to the Headmaster to arrange random drug tests at his/her discretion.
8. Signing of this document implies that parents/guardians are aware:
 - a) That Mountain Cambridge School's medium of instruction is English.
 - b) That the prospectus and constitution of Mountain Cambridge School is accepted and underwritten.
 - c) That the code of conduct of Mountain Cambridge School is accepted and underwritten.
 - d) That parents/guardians commit themselves to accept the decisions of the Headmaster and or Governing Body regarding the school's organisation and discipline.
 - e) That all complaints regarding rules, regulations, policies and procedures must be directed to the Headmaster.
 - f) That students are expected to attend all official school days including school events which the school deems compulsory.
9. The following regarding finances is important; on processing the application, the school may undertake a credit check and the school may deem it necessary to refuse acceptance or to charge an additional term's school fees to be held as a deposit and used in the event of a non-payment of school fees.
